## Transitional Funding

Transitioning to a new career can come with unexpected costs. **Upon accepting your offer to join us in 2022, you will receive \$1,000.00 in transitional support.** Also, aspiring educators are eligible to apply for **up to \$3,000 in additional needs-based funding.** Funds are dispersed twice a year for approved applicants.



## Income Support & Salary Outlook

### YEAR ONE

- Resident stipend or salary of at least **\$21,500**

### YEAR TWO & BEYOND

- Full-time employment with an approximate starting salary of **\$50,000** and full-time benefits packages including medical, dental, paid time off, and more
- Opportunities for a salary increase vary by district for teachers with a master's degree and/or highly effective performance reviews.
